**RE: Nigeria Cargo Acceptance Policy**

Dear MOL Customer:

In order to comply with the Harmful Waste Act in Nigeria, MOL has developed the following cargo acceptance policy for Nigeria.

The following goods will not be accepted:

- Used electronics\*
- Used functional electronics\*
- Used electrical appliances\*
- Used vehicles more than 15 years of age from the date of manufacture
- Used refrigerators / air compressors / air conditioners / freezers
- Used batteries
- Used non-functional electronics and electrical goods

*\*Even when the importer is certified by the National Environmental Standards and Regulations Enforcement Agency (NESREA)*

The following goods will be accepted:

- Used engines/motor parts
- Used motorcycles
- Used cars not more than 15 years of age from the date of manufacture
- Household appliances – non-electrical (2<sup>nd</sup> hand/used)

In the case of commodity descriptions like household and personal effects, MOL will ask for a detailed description of the contents of the container. If shipments labeled as household and personal effects contain any of the commodities in the above list, then MOL will not accept these shipments.
