Re: West Africa - Peak Season Surcharge July 1st, 2007

Dear Our Valued Customers

Due to seasonal demand, shipping lines experience high and sustained vessel utilization through the summer weeks. This increased demand puts extra burden upon our vessels and equipment and increases operating costs over and above those levels which are normally endured, particularly:

1. Equipment imbalance
2. Increase Terminal Congestion
3. Cost of On (and Off) Hiring containers

For this reason, MOL, will introduce a Peak Season Surcharge (PSS) to apply to all outbound shipments from Asia (including Indonesia) of **US\$ 200 / 400 / 400 per 20' / 40' / 40'HQ.**

The PSS will be applied with effect from **01st July 2007** onwards although Lines may, after giving due notice, amend this should conditions in the trade warrant such a change.
